DEDDINGTON,

A market town on the borders of Northamptonshire, 16 miles N. from Oxford, and 6½ miles S. from Banbury, contained, in 1831, 2078 inhabitants; the annual value of assessed property in 1815, was 8110*l*. The Birmingham and Oxford Canal passes within 2 miles eastward, by which means the trade has been greatly improved. Deddington is noted for the superior quality of its ale; the market is on Saturday, and fairs are held on August 21st, Saturday after October 10th, and November 22d, for horses, cows, and swine. The town is governed by a bailiff, who is chosen annually. The church, dedicated to St. Peter and St. Paul, is a spacious edifice; and the living is a vicarage value 133*l*. per annum, in the patronage of the Dean and Canons of Windsor. Sir Thomas Pope, the founder of Trinity College, Oxford, was a native of this place, and founded the free grammar School here. At Deddington was formerly a castle, the foundations of which may still be traced. Clifton and Hempton are townships in this parish; it is in Woodstock union, and containing two medicinal springs, one of them strongly impregnated with vitriolic salt.
